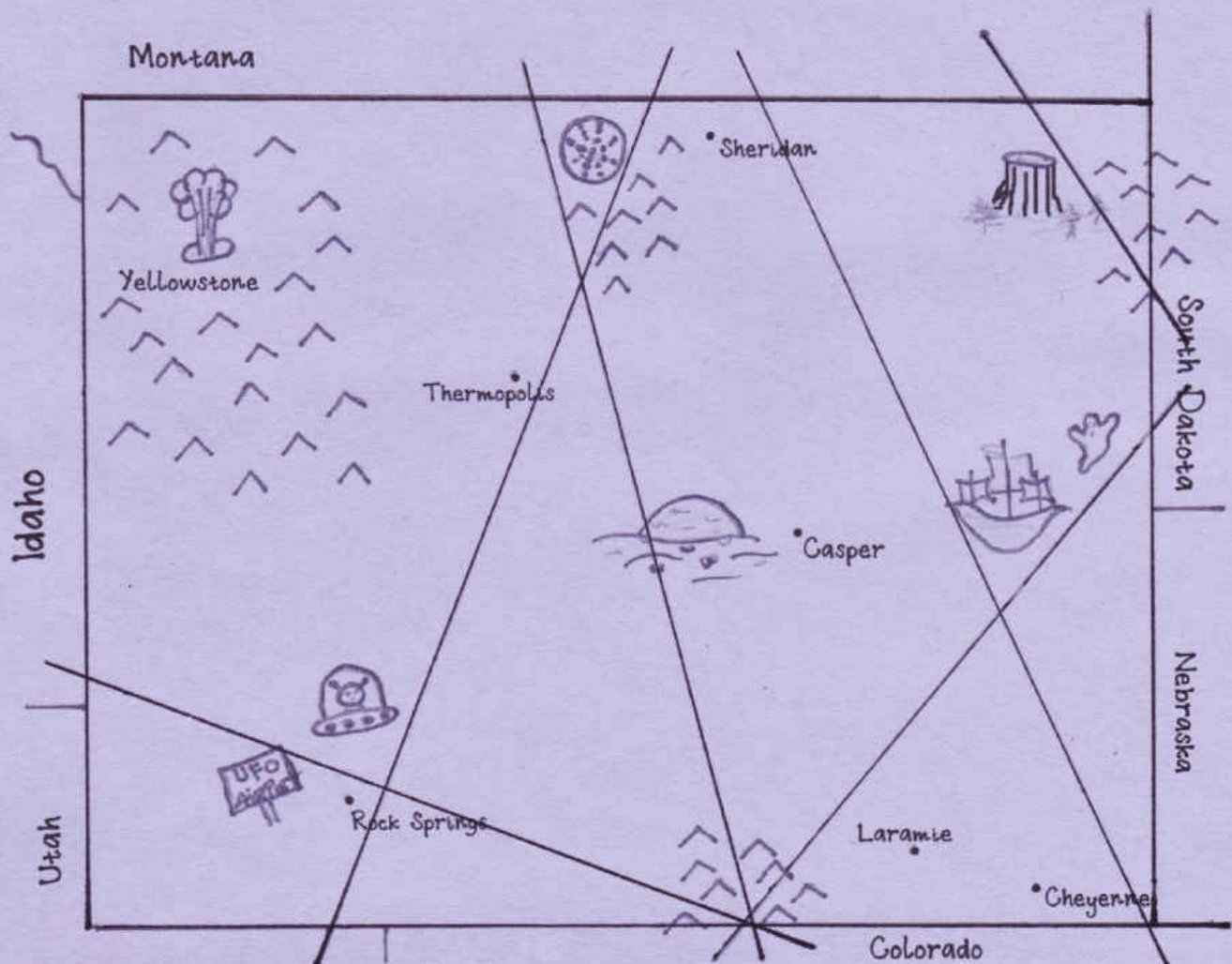

Introduction

This is the second in a series of books about various anomalies found in the United States and how these anomalies are possibly related as well as being associated with Ley Lines or Earth Energy

Lines. I am writing about them on a state by state basis, making it easier for those who would like to visit these areas and see for themselves the mysteries which reside there.

I have read extensively on the topics of Ley Lines and Energy Grids and the oddities found near them. This is my interpretation, my understanding, of how the energies found along these grid lines may interact with local geology and other natural elements to create and/or enhance mankind's (un)earthly experiences. I reference the books and websites from which I obtained information. Many of the tales of the unexplained have come from people I encountered throughout my life.

While the science of Ley Lines is still in its infancy, many knowledgeable people have come to similar if not the same conclusions about them. There is an invisible (to most people) energy grid which encompasses the Earth. This grid is the source of magnetic anomalies, power surges, strange sightings in the sky and on the ground, and the location of remnants of ancient civilizations.

Ley Lines were often, and still are, scoffed at. Those people who have felt the pull, seen the unseen, and have been able to locate this Earth Energy Grid are believers. It is these people who have left the naysayers behind and continued to do the research necessary to further the understanding and knowledge of this ancient energy system. Many thanks to them for persevering.

It is my belief that the Earth Energy Grid has been a source of inspiration, enlightenment, and energy since time immemorial. Is it a coincidence that ancient mysteries and oddities are located on or near Ley Lines? Not likely in the majority of cases. Our Ancient Ancestors knew more about the environment in which they lived than we can even possibly imagine. They built magnificent structures on these grids. Unique petroglyphs were used to mark locations of portals and vortexes. Strange occurrences and odd beings have been seen on or around these energetic sites for centuries. Our Ancestors, the Ancient Ones, were able to utilize these energies to their advantage and advancement. Unfortunately, we have lost the instruction manual for what possibly might be the greatest tool we could possibly hope to utilize in our search for knowledge and

enlightenment – Earth's Energy Lines. May we have the strength to open our hearts and souls so that we may find answers.

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Part 1 Ley Lines

Overview

To better understand the occurrences which take place on or near ley lines, a basic understanding of ley lines is needed.

There are a variety of ley lines; some producing good energy while others produce dark or bad energy. Many follow fault lines (or do the earthquake fault lines follow the energy lines?) while others follow a more geomagnetic path. While they are all different, they are also the same. Ley lines receive their energy from either the sun, the moon, or the Earth's geomagnetism. Ley lines produce energy which can influence living organisms located near them, they can influence mankind through enabling enlightenment, and strange phenomenon can be seen near them.

Some people believe that ley lines are the invisible lines which connect man-made sacred sites - ancient monuments, henges, standing stones and megalithic structures – rather than the actual energy line. These structures were built on an existing power grid which the ancient peoples knew about. Where their knowledge of this earth energy grid system came from is anyone's guess. Folklore says the Ancients were told of these grids by the Star People. Others say that the Ancients were better in tune with the Earth and were able to sense them or even dowse for them like many people do today. I use the term ley line to refer to the naturally occurring energy grid which encircles the Earth.

Types of Energy Lines

There are several earth grids and energy waves - Becker & Hagens Grid, Hartmann Grid, Curry Grid, Black Lines, Vile Vortices, Potential Portals, and the Schumann Wave. I will write briefly about each of these and hopefully explain how they are relevant to our world.

The first written account of earth grid lines came from Plato in his writings, **Timeaus** . Plato theorized that the planet Earth evolved from simple geometric shapes into more complex ones. These geometric shapes became known as the Platonic Solids. Plato associated each of the five shapes - cube, tetrahedron, octahedron, dodecahedron, and icosahedron - with an element - earth, fire, air, ether (Universe), water. The Earth's Energy Grid evolved through each of these shapes over time into what it is today.

Ivan T. Sanderson, a Scottish biologist and writer, was the first to postulate about the relationship of the icosahedron shape and the Earth. Sanderson claimed that there are twelve geographic areas that are alleged to all have the same mysterious disappearances occur within them. Of these twelve locations, five are located on the same latitude north of the equator, five are located on the same latitude south of the equator, and the remaining two are located at the North Pole and the South Pole. These areas were called Vile Vortices by Sanderson. The Bermuda Triangle, the Devil's Sea near Japan, and the South Atlantic Anomaly are a few of the Vile Vortices.

In 1973, a Russian team of scientists took Sanderson's theory one step further. They overlaid a combination of icosahedrons and dodecahedrons over Sanderson's map; lining up seismic zones, ocean ridges, gravitational anomalies, sites of ancient civilizations (known at the time) and routes used by migratory animals.

Bill Becker and Bethe Hagens then added to the map generated by the Russian team. They superimposed a spherical polyhedron (developed by R. Buckminster Fuller) over the Russian planetary grid map. This is known as the Becker & Hagens Grid.

The Hartmann Grid was discovered in 1954 by Ernst Hartmann. This grid is associated with the Earth's magnetic field and influenced by the sun. These lines run in a north to south direction as well as east to west. The Hartmann Grid is often called the Global Grid.

The Curry Grid is named after Manfred Curry, though it was discovered by Siegfried Wittmann in 1950. The Curry Grid runs at a 45degree angle to the Hartmann Grid and encircles the Earth. It is believed that the Moon, not the Sun, influences the strength of this grid. During a full moon, the Curry Grid will have exceptionally strong energy levels at the points where it crosses the Hartmann Grid. There is speculation that where the Curry Grid crosses underground waterways, the energy can be especially dangerous.

Black lines are naturally occurring energy with no real pattern or grid formation. How these lines are generated is unknown and often they are confined to a local area. Regardless, these energy lines are of a negative type of energy.

The width of ley lines can vary greatly. Some can be miles wide while others can be so narrow that there will be many ley lines within a mile's distance.

Portals or openings to other dimensions or wormholes to other universes are thought to exist at the junctions of ley lines. Various Anomalies, including UFOs, Ghosts, and Cryptids, have been reported at specific points around the globe. These specific points are generally located at places where ley lines cross and their energies mix.

The Schumann Wave or Schumann Frequency is the name given to the frequency which is generated by the Earth as it rotates on its axis. This rotation causes the Earth to act as an electro-magnet by generating electrical current in the metals found in its core and an electromagnetic field is generated on the surface. The frequency of this surface field is 7.83 Hz, which is almost the same as alpha brainwaves in humans. Physicist W.O. Schumann identified this

frequency in 1952. Distortions to this frequency can occur from underground water ways, fault lines, underground caverns, mineral deposits, and man-made structures such as roads, railways, underground utilities, tall buildings or towers. There is a theory that states that as the strength of the magnetic poles weakens, the frequency of the Earth becomes lower. This lower frequency causes stronger influences of ley lines on life forms.

Telluric current is an electric current which moves underground or through the sea. Telluric currents result from both natural causes and human activity, and the separate currents interact in a complex pattern. The currents are extremely low frequency and travel over large areas at or near the surface of the Earth.

Locating Energy Lines

Ley lines can be located by dowsing for them. An experienced dowser can follow an energy line across hill and valley. While most energy lines run fairly straight, many are attracted to depressions like valleys, holes in the ground or even empty vessels. When searching for a ley line, go to a sacred site and try locating the energy there as a starting point. Once a person has a feel for the energy, it will become easier to locate a ley line 'out in the open'. Another method to locate earth energy lines is to use a Lobe Antenna which was developed by Dr. Ernst Hartmann to trace the Hartmann Grid.

Geometry also comes into play when the location of ley lines are being determined. Becker & Hagens took their revamped map and developed it further to a grid based on the rhombic triacontahedron. This new grid has 30 diamond-shaped faces but it also revealed 15 great circles, 120 scalene right triangles and 62

node points. The great circles divided each rhombic face into four right triangles. This model was named "The Rings of Gaia" by Becker & Hagens. This model was later developed into the 'Unified Vector Geometry' theory, which connects all the vertices of the five Platonic Solids placed inside a sphere. Interestingly, Buckminster Fuller had previously noted the four right triangles which came from the division of the rhombic face. Fuller recorded the internal angles in planar and spherical notations. Those internal angles are what was used to divide the right triangles.

For the sake of this book, I am using the Becker & Hagens Grid. I am also using the sacred geometry angles which Fuller made note of.

Influences & Energy Lines

Ley lines have a dramatic influence on living beings. Many maladies, insomnia, lowered immune systems, disorientation, hallucinations, can occur from negative energy or from the energies produced by the intersecting of multiple energy lines. Vegetation can become distorted and have a shortened life span. Animal life generally avoids such places, instinctively knowing the detrimental effects of the dark energy. The Ancient Peoples often built temples, henges, and other sacred structures on positive energy lines. These structures would often be built from specific stones which contained quartz or magnetite or iron. The electrical energy or telluric energy at these locations would interact with the composition of these stones possibly altering the Schumann Frequency and causing visions to appear to people within these sites. Shamans and priests would utilize this system. It is believed that the interaction of the telluric current and the stones would cause the pineal gland to vibrate and visions would be the result. The stones used in building these sacred sites could store the earth energy and it would later be accessed.

Ley lines may also be influenced by other things - water, both moving and stationary, geology, time of day, seasonal changes. Ley lines vary in width and where two lines intersect, their influence will radiate out around the point of intersection. The circle of influence can vary in size.

Anomalies & Energy Lines

Petroglyphs (carved images in stone) can often be found near earth energy lines. Certain specific shapes and patterns can be found across the globe. Perhaps there was once a global society who utilized rock carvings to mark special vortices, portals or other unique earth energies. There is also the thought that when specific petroglyphs or images are placed together in a specific order, the portal, vortex, or energy would be activated. Some of the most common petroglyphs found across the globe are circles, spirals, zoomorphic humans or horned humans. It is believed that a serpent carved on an ancient temple or stone is meant to signify that this is a location where telluric current passes through the site. Circles and Spirals are believed to represent a portal or place of extreme energy production.

Ley Lines have been shown to have more energy during the day than at night, leading to the conclusion that they receive, at least, some of their energy from the sun - either directly or in a round-about way. Scientists have confirmed that the Earth 'connects' to the sun approx. every eight minutes through magnetic portals. These portals are as wide as the Earth and an exchange of magnetic energy takes place. Is the Earth's magnetic energy being recharged through these portals? Is the magnetic energy charging the ley lines? Could the sun be imbedding universal knowledge in the energy lines for people to access?

Water is a conductor of electricity. So it is no surprise that water and waterways attract geomagnetic lines. Locate underground water sources and chances are you'll locate a ley line. Strange floating lights can often be seen near where a water source, especially moving water, and a ley line intersect.

When a building is placed along an energy line as well as being located near an underground water source, the atmosphere inside and outside of the building will become charged electrically and light phenomenon can occur. This charge can also affect the people in close proximity by changing their mood or behavior or way of thinking. The composition of the building material of temples, henges, etc. which are built on the energy grid greatly influences the effect of that site.

Magnetic Anomalies can occur on or near ley lines, standing stones and henges. Magnets will read inaccurately and electronic devices will malfunction. Perhaps the telluric currents are interacting with the stones and causing interference. The geography over which ley lines run, often contain quartz, granite, limestone, or iron. All these can effect electrical or magnetic currents. Magnetite increases the magnetic properties. Granite can cause an even greater magnetic influence.

Ancient People knew more than modern society gives them credit for. They used earth energy lines to locate their temples, cities, and ceremonial sites. Often archeo-astronomical sites - places where the solstice or equinox would be seen - are located in proximity to these energy grids. Today, modern man has located military bases, large utility plants, and major political buildings along these very same grids.

Paranormal activity can also be found in these areas. Perhaps the energy generated along these lines provides a way for spirits or other beings to manifest. Perhaps the energy enables the veil to thin between dimensions or it opens a wormhole between universes. If this is the case, then it would explain why the majority of UFO sightings occur along ley lines.

UFOs are thought to work on a type of anti-gravity propulsion system. In school we learned that a magnet will repel or move away a magnet of like polarity. Perhaps the pilots of these craft are utilizing this effect to move their craft, aided by an energy line. Does their appearance along ley lines support this theory?

Earth lights are another phenomenon which can be seen near Earth's energy grid. These lights could be from the fault lines which are generally located near energy grid lines. Scientists have found that the friction of the tectonic plates can cause a buildup of electrical energy (think static electricity) and this energy is then dispelled into the atmosphere. Perhaps the electrical energy is given an extra boost by the energy grid line – almost as if the energy grid was breathing life into the electrical energy.

The best way to access the energy which flows along ley lines is by physical contact. Walking barefoot provides a good way for the currents to flow into the body. A health benefit called Grounding or Earthing is based upon this. Connecting to the earth increases the number of electrons in a person's body which then improves the immune system and has an antioxidant effect.

Regardless, if you are a serious researcher or simply someone out on a weekend adventure, be sure to respect all posted signs and fence boundaries. Take only pictures and never, ever do anything which might harm the environment. And most importantly have fun!

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* Author's Note*

This book is set up a little differently from the first book I published about the state of Colorado and its anomalies. Instead of areas, I have numbered the grid lines and write on the various anomalies, geology, aquifers, etc. associated with each ley line. There is a section for each numbered line. At the beginning of each section will be a map with the ley line drawn on it.

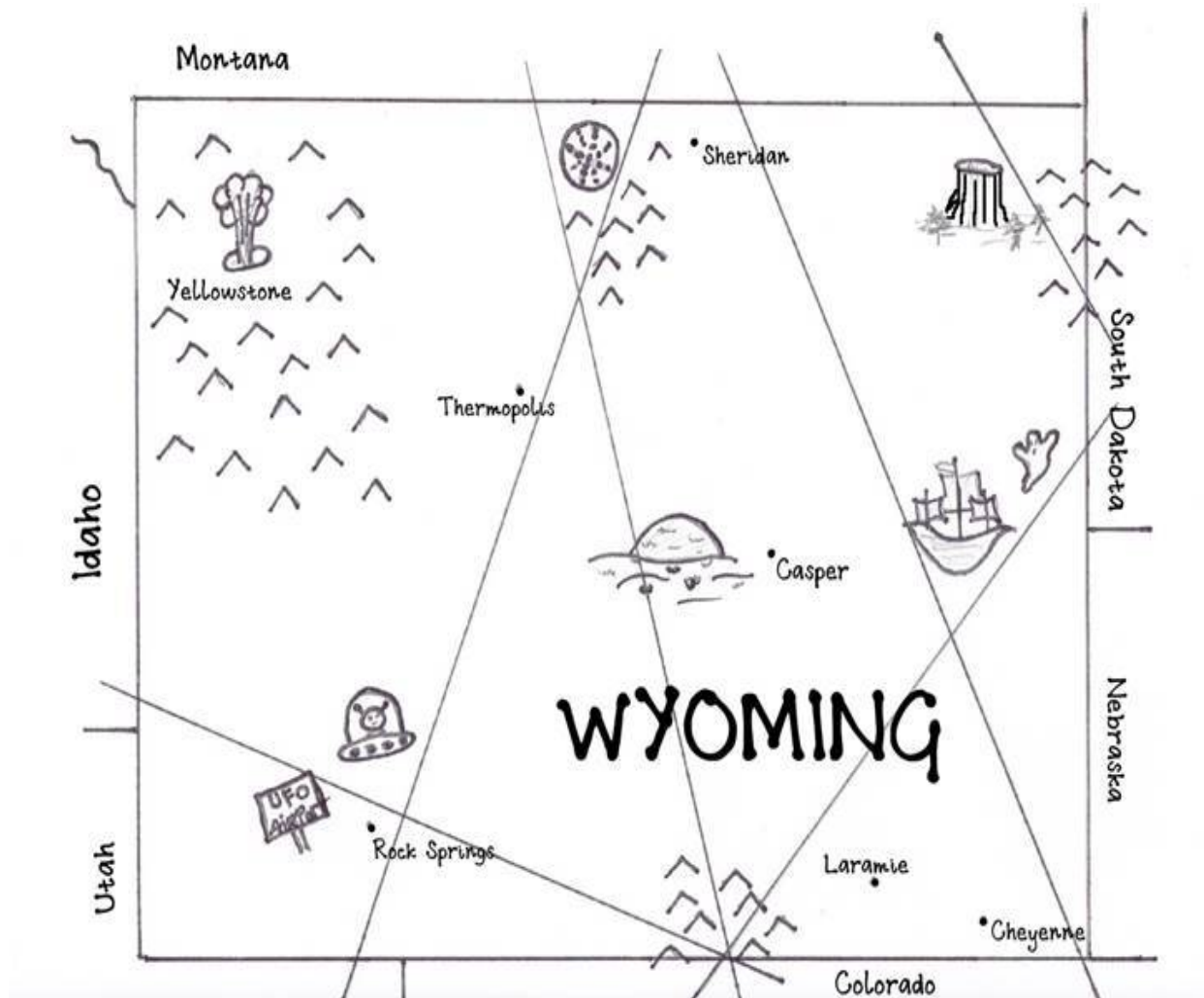
Wyoming is still a vast and sparsely populated state. The land is mostly rolling plains punctuated by mountain ranges. Rivers have carved picturesque gorges through the rock as they flow ever onwards toward the sea. It is an ancient landscape abundant with wildlife. Wyoming is an amazing place with an equally amazing history both real and surreal.

Wyoming's mountain ranges are all part of the Rocky Mountains. Most of the mountain ranges have very old rocks, billions of years old, in their cores. The two exceptions are the Absaroka Range, which is young volcanic rock related to the Yellowstone area, and the Wyoming Range, which is faulted strata of a much younger age (hundreds of millions of years). Other major ranges are the Bighorn Mountains, Black Hills, Wind River Range, Granite Mountains, Laramie Mountains and Medicine Bow Mountains.

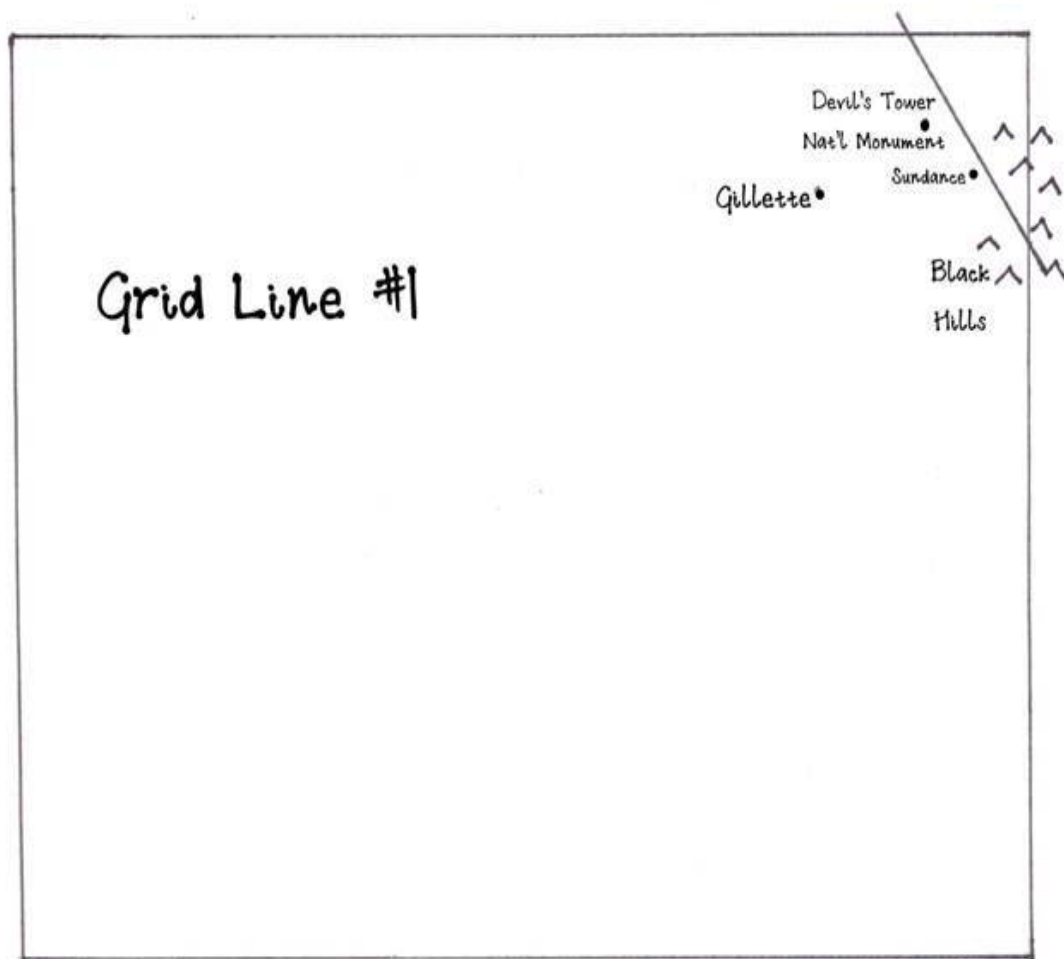
Between the mountains lie large sedimentary basins which have large resources of coal, oil and gas as well as abundant fossils. The Green River basin is especially noted for its [fossil fish](#) and other marine life. Wyoming is also a major uranium producer. Another resource produced in Wyoming is soda ash (sodium carbonate) and bentonite, a clay mineral used in drilling muds.

Most of Wyoming is at a high earthquake risk with the most active faults situated on the west side of the state. Only the northeast & southeast corners have the lowest risk. This author's observations see a greater coincidence between petroglyphs, ghostly apparitions, and other anomalies and active earthquake areas. Active earthquake zones will create more electric charges which may 'feed' these energy lines. There are faults lines - not necessarily very active fault lines - near every intersection of grid lines. There is also a fault line near the Fossil Butte National Monument and Independence Rock.

Part 2 Wyoming Anomalous Areas



Grid Line #1



This line runs roughly northwest to southeast across the northeastern corner of the state. The line runs through the western edge of the Black Hills and is also very near to Devil's Tower National Monument. Devil's Tower is probably best known for the role it played in the movie, *Close Encounters of the Third Kind*. And both Devil's Tower and the Black Hills are known for their UFO sightings - strange lights and flying craft of varying shapes and sizes.

Devil's Tower is a prominent landmark of this region. The mysteries of its origins still plague scientists. Some say that it was once a volcanic cone, erosion causing the majority of the outer layers to fall away, leaving the hardened magma in the center for us to see today. But no other signs of volcanic activity are seen in this area so this path of thought may not necessarily be accurate. Other scientists

believe that magma was forced through cracks in the earth's crust and then hardened before reaching the surface. Over time the magma cone was uplifted leaving the cone shape we see today. American Indian tribes who traveled through this area have their own stories about its origins. But the name of Devil's Tower is not what these tribes know it by. The names range from Tree Rock to Bear Rock, with several versions of the Bear theme - Bear Mountain, Bear Rock, Bear Lodge. Most of the origin stories consist of a couple of children or people being chased by a bear only to be saved by the large stump or rock or tower which seemed to spring upwards towards the sky saving the people involved. The deep lines down the sides of the tower were made by the bear as he tried to climb upwards. It is a sacred site for many tribes, Lakota, Crow, Arapaho, and Cheyenne to name just a few. This is a place of origin for many tribes and sacred rituals were performed here. The Lakota performed their Sun Dance here around the summer solstice. A vortex is said to be here near Devil's Tower. Perhaps that is what the UFOs are using as a portal to their dimension.

The Black Hills extend from Wyoming into both Montana and South Dakota. They are considered to be some of the oldest mountains in the world, billions of years old. The mineral hot springs here have been visited for generations by many tribes, some as far away as Canada. These mountains are another sacred site to the Lakota who believe that they are the heart of everything. And interestingly, when viewed from above, the mountains appear in the shape of a heart (not the a-typical heart shape but more like a real human heart). The Black Hills are a granite batholith that rose from the sandstone. Granite can act like a simple battery or power generator and increase the electrical activity in the area and in a sense breathe life into the surrounding area. That may be the reason this area is so sacred. In the late 1800's, miners and prospectors came to the Black Hills, so named because the dense forestation caused the hillsides to appear black, seeking gold. This forever changed the area which was sacred to so many.

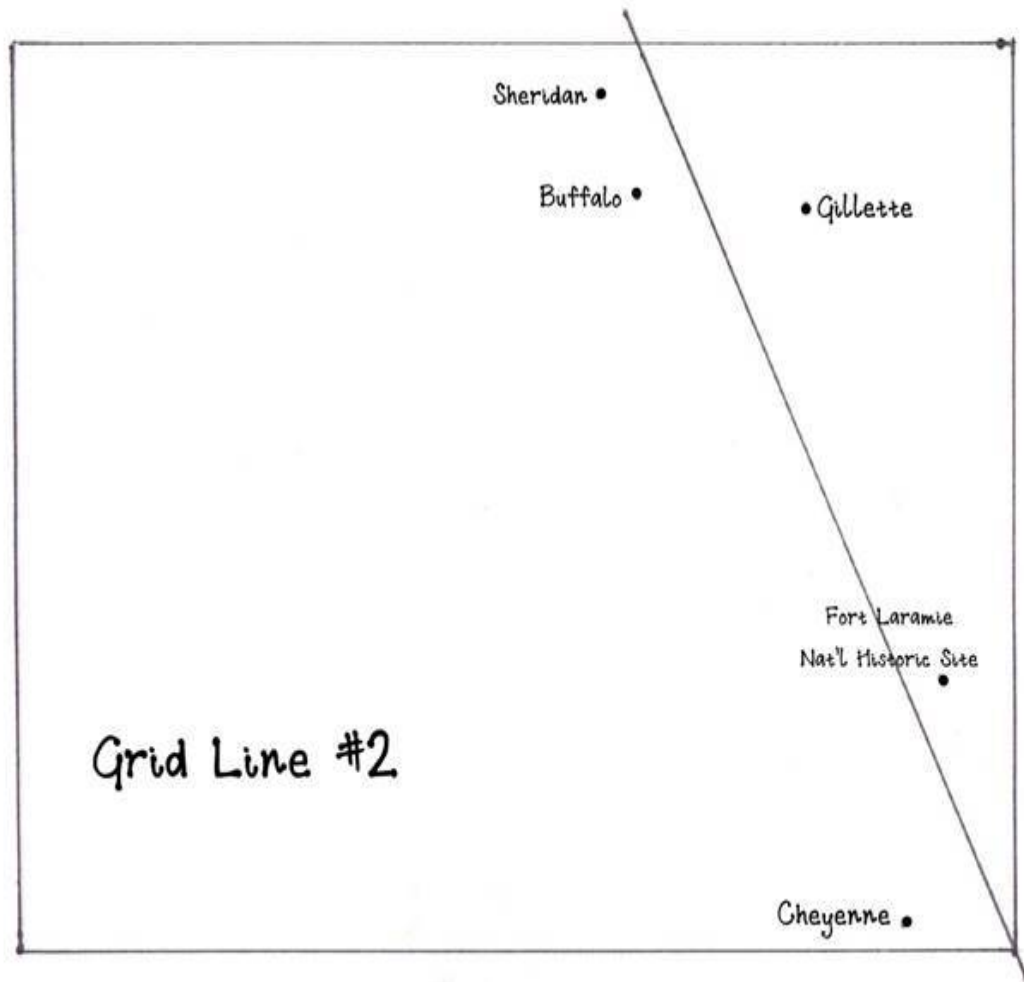
No active fault lines are nearby even though the northern part of the Black Hills were created by volcanic activity. The southern part of the range consists of granite, a piezoelectric rock. Could the energy generated by the granite help to power the nearby vortex?

Cryptid sightings along this energy line consist of Sasquatch in the Black Hills as well as Black Panther sightings. The term panther can refer to a species of jaguar or even a mountain lion who is black or a very dark brown. Specters clothed in dark robes have reportedly chased people in the vicinity of Devil's Tower.

This energy line runs across a sandstone aquifer called the lower cretaceous aquifer for its entire length.

It is somewhere in this area (between Line 1 & Line 2) of the state that unusual rock formations occur - balls of rocks situated on pedestals. And that is exactly what they look like. A ball that is balanced on a pedestal. Scientists claim they were made by erosion. But were they?

Grid Line #2



This energy line parallels Energy Line #1 and extends roughly from just east of Sheridan to the southeast corner of the state. It passes close to Douglas, Wheatland and Fort Laramie Historic Site. The terrain along this line is rolling plains which are carved by the mighty rivers which flow through here.

This part of eastern Wyoming is sparsely populated with few significant landmarks or other notable markers. Two-thirds of the way down the energy line from the north, the North Platte River is crossed by the energy line. It is in this area that a ghost ship has been reported being seen sailing the South Platte River. The ship will appear in a mist which rapidly thickens to a fog. The ship's crew can be seen standing on the deck around a body laid out on a sail. It is said that the sighting of this ship foretells the death of someone close

to the person sighting the ship. It is near here that energy line #6 crosses energy line #2. Could this combined energy cause the veil between worlds to thin, allowing the future to be seen by way of the Ghost Ship?

The end of the energy line crosses the state line where Wyoming, Colorado and Nebraska meet. Coincidence that the states meet here?

Wyoming's state capital, Cheyenne is not too far to the east of this energy line. It is there in Cheyenne that the only military base in Wyoming can be found. It is an Air Force base. And while Wyoming is peppered with rocket silos, this author did not take the time to research their locations.

There is a rumor of an underground military base near the beginning of the grid line close to Sheridan. There are also reports of 'mole people' being seen in that area. Could the two be related?

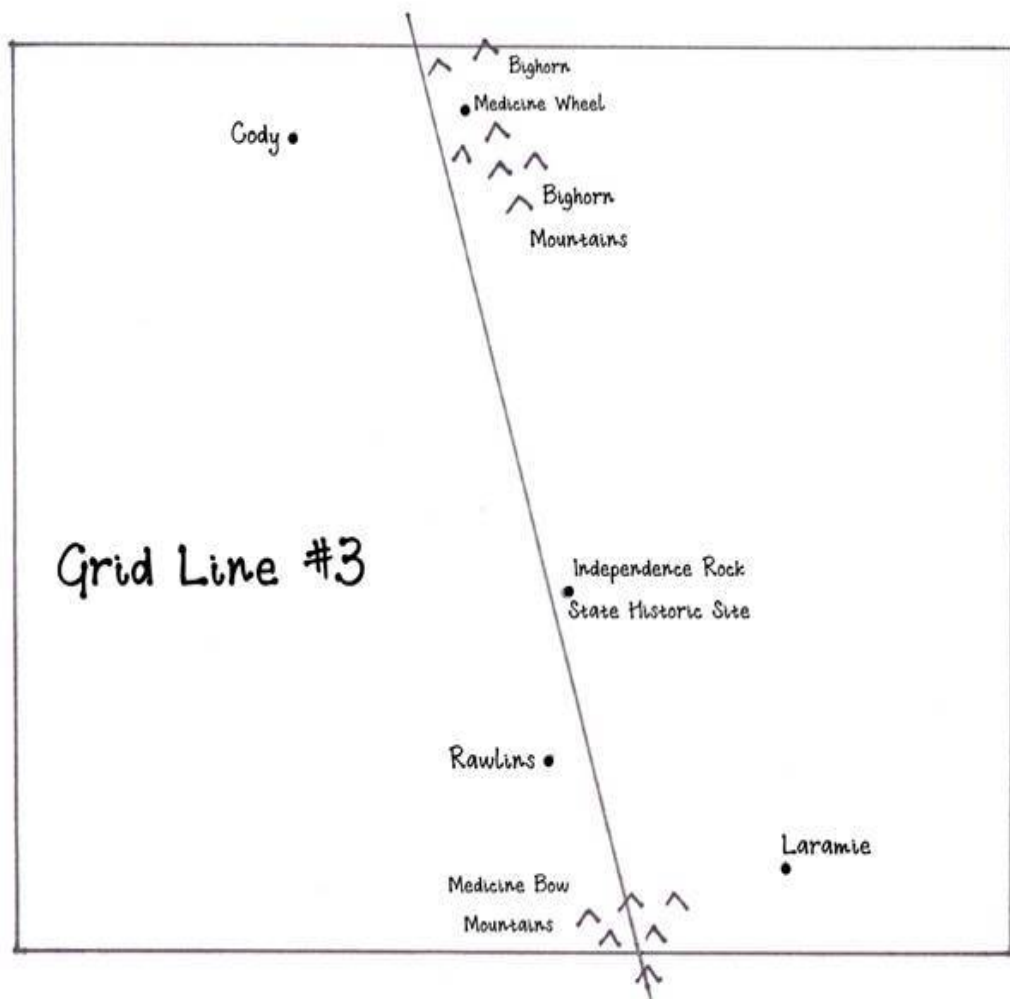
UFOs are frequently seen between the intersection of energy Lines #2 and #6 and Cheyenne. Perhaps the combined energy of the lines draws them in or maybe they are keeping tabs on the Air Force Base in Cheyenne. Unexplained sightings of lights and unusually shaped craft are also frequently spotted near the beginning of Energy Line #2 in the north (Sheridan area). Interesting that UFOs are spotted in areas where other anomalies occur...

While very few Sasquatch sightings are reported along this energy line, there is a cryptid reported in Lake DeSmet which is located between Sheridan and Buffalo. This lake, which runs parallel to the energy line, is home to Smetty, a plesiosaur type creature. Because of the caves in the area, could a creature from the Cretaceous period, when Wyoming was more swamp-like, have survived? The Crow Indians say the lake is haunted by a moaning spirit who rises from the lake to find its next victim. It is reported that

animals are spooked by the lake. Maybe they know something we don't.

Grid Line #2 Runs across a sandstone aquifer for 2/3 of its length (to the intersection of lines) - the lower tertiary aquifer and the remainder goes across a sand & gravel aquifer named the High Plains aquifer.

Grid Line #3



This line runs parallel (somewhat) to the two previous energy lines. It crosses the Wyoming/Montana border just to the east of Bighorn Lake and continues on a southeasterly course to a point at

the Wyoming/Colorado border where it crosses two other grid lines. This intersection takes place on the south edge of the Medicine Bow Mountains.

I feel this line is influenced by the other lines it crosses - three in total: two near the state line with Colorado and the third is farther north, Wyoming Grid Line #4 - perhaps giving the line more energy, more power.

Not far from the northerly end of Grid Line #3 is the Bighorn Medicine Wheel. This is a large 80 foot circular man-made formation constructed from rocks. There are several rock cairns which point to various stars as well as marking the Summer Solstice. Because of the elevation, (9642ft) the medicine wheel is only accessible during the summer months. The alignment of the rock cairns with their respective stars tell researchers that the cairn dates back to the 1200's - since then there has been a slight shift in the position of the stars due to minor shifts in the Earth's orbit. But the use of the area goes back much further than that. There is evidence to suggest that the Medicine Mountain area was used by Native American Indians for 7000 years. The energy is strong here. People who have visited this region have reported a strong feeling permeating the ridge the Medicine Wheel sits upon. Some people say the energy is almost oppressive. While others have a very spiritual experience. Besides evidence of people long gone, there are numerous caves hiding amongst the trees of the Bighorn National Forest.

There are 10 places in the world called "nuclei of continents". These are widely separated places of relatively small patches of ancient rocks, 2-3 billion years old. Overlying younger rock has worn away. These spots are thought to be the relatively small nuclei which first cooled and then built up and grew by volcanic activity and sediment deposits into a single huge island (called Gondwanaland) that began to break up in the Carboniferous era (300,000,000 years ago). These nuclei separated, drifting on continental plates of ancient rockbed, into our present continents sometime between 65,000,000

and about 1,000,000 years ago (the continental plates continue to drift).

Medicine Mountain is one of these rare ancient continental roots. The cutaway profile shows layers of rock color-coded by age, the youngest lying in the valleys where the Bighorn and Powder Rivers run, and the oldest silhouetted against the sky with ancient roots going down deep into earth.

The Medicine Wheel sits upon a ridge with nearly a 360 degree view of the valleys below. Along the mountain's ridge, rocks of an ancient age are exposed to the sky but these rocks do not go very far north or south of the Medicine Wheel, although the outward physical appearance of the mountains is the same. The Medicine Wheel has been placed on some of the world's oldest rocks, perhaps for a reason.

There are many legends about the Medicine Wheel, many of which have a common thread - there are Little People who live in the Earth and they will sometimes take humans there. Could they be living in the caves that are found in the forest?

The true builders of the Medicine Wheel are unknown. Some believe it was the ancient people who traveled across the Bering Land Bridge to settle the Americas. While others feel that ancient Celtic tribes made their way across the Atlantic to what is now Canada, bringing their knowledge of astronomy with them.

*side note - there have been over 70 medicine wheels identified in South Dakota, Wyoming, and Montana in the U.S. along with Alberta and Saskatchewan in Canada.

Sasquatch sightings have been reported in this area. And this is one of the regions where there is an unusual number of missing people reported. Some may simply get lost in the wilderness, others may try exploring one of the many caves only to find themselves

injured and unable to get help. While others may not go willingly into the caves...

As the line continues southward, it leaves the mountains and enters the prairies. It passes to the east of Independence Rock, a large granite outcropping reminiscent of Uluru in Australia (formerly Ayer's Rock). This unique landmark was used by early settlers as they crossed the prairie on their way to the west coast of America. If the pioneers reached the rock by July 4th, then they knew that they could be over the Rockies before the snow flew. Independence Rock was the site of the first Masonic Lodge meeting in Wyoming, taking place on July 4, 1862. Interestingly, the granite which composes this rock is conducive for ley energy.....

It is in the region of Independence Rock that a ghostly white stallion is sometimes seen. It is said that this unearthly specter guarded the wild mustangs from capture by cowboys. The stallion would attack the cowboys when they tried to rope the wild horses.

As we continue south, the energy line passes along the western edge of the Pedro Mountains. A unique formation of pink granite rocks which are part of a larger mountain range, the Granite Mountains. It is here in this remote area that the mummified remains of Little People have been found. The first mummy was found in the 1930s when two men prospecting for gold dynamited what they thought was solid rock only to discover a cave. In the cave was a ledge with a small mummified body sitting on it. The two men took their find to Casper where it was examined by scientists of the day from the American Museum of Natural History. The mummy was roughly 6 1/2 inches tall in a sitting position and was estimated to be about 14 inches if it were standing. The age of the little person (at the time of death) was estimated to be roughly 65 years of age. The mummy was a sideshow display for a period of time, then made its way to New York where it wasn't seen again after the owner's death in the 1980s. But this was not the only evidence of a little person that

has been found in the United States. And it isn't the only one found in Wyoming either.

In 1929, a man made a purchase from a sheepherder in Wyoming. The item purchased was the mummified remains of a small person with wispy strands of blonde hair. The mummy was passed down in the family, stuck away for safe keeping. Then in 1994, a professor at the University of Wyoming had the chance to study the small being. It was determined that the mummy had Native American DNA, died in the 1500s, and had been born with a birth defect. The similarities between Chiquita, as the small mummy was called, and the other small mummy (a.k.a. Pedro Mountain Mummy) which had been found by prospectors were eerie. (The professors later went on to surmise that the Pedro Mountain mummy was also that of a diseased child). The owners of Chiquita only allowed the professor 3 days to examine her. After that she was taken back by the family never to be seen again.

Considering that many Native Indian tribes have legends and tales of Little People who live in caves or in the earth, might these two enigmas be real?

As the energy line nears the Wyoming/Colorado border, it goes through the Medicine Bow Mountains. This mountain range is close to the point of convergence of three ley lines. There has always been an air of mystique about the Medicine Bow Mountains. People visiting here, speak of a feeling of sacredness. Of a sense of age and wisdom. Numerous sightings of Sasquatch have been reported but only an occasional UFO. And not a lot of missing person reports despite the mountain range's ruggedness. An area to the east of the Medicine Bow Mountains, called Vedauwoo, is considered sacred and is reported to be the location of many vision quests made by the young men of the tribes who made their way through this country. Vedauwoo is composed of ancient granite that has eroded to form strange and eerie shapes, sometimes known as hoodoos. One formation is named Turtle Rock.

The exposed granite along this grid line might bring to the surface energies of an ancient origin. Energies that contain ancient wisdom. Perhaps if we sit quietly, we may hear the words whispered on the wind.

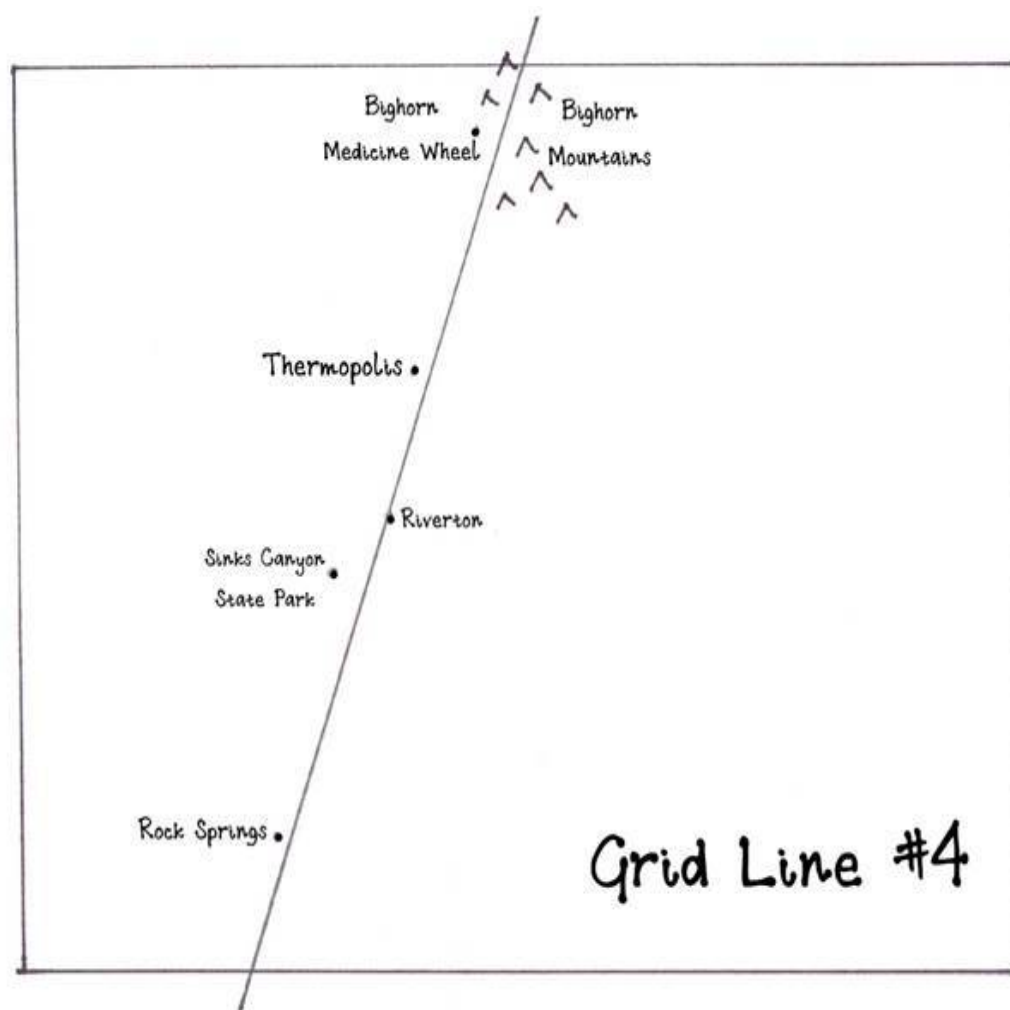
It seems that the intersection of grid lines has a strong influence over a wide area. The effects of where grid lines #3, #4, and #6 come together in the Medicine Bow Mountains can be felt beyond the actual point of intersection. I mention this because to the northeast of that point, on Interstate 80 are two items of note. The first being a pine tree which grows from a granite rock. This tree was first found in the 1860s by railroad workers. What makes it more notable, is the fact that it sits between the lanes of the road and on the rolling prairie. No majestic mountains for this scrappy evergreen! The second item is a pyramid which was built from pink granite - pink granite, remember, is made of pink feldspar, quartz, mica and hornblende and is a very ancient rock, originating in the depths of the earth. This pyramid was built by two brothers who were highly instrumental in getting funding to build the Transcontinental Railroad. The pyramid stands over 60 feet tall. It was once located by the railroad tracks but the tracks have since been rerouted and now the pyramid stands as a solitary sentinel on the Wyoming prairie. Can anyone say road trip?

Along this energy line are several mountain ranges, all are ancient with precious metals and gems to be found. The Granite Mountains near the central part of the line are home to gold deposits as well as jade, ruby and sapphire. The Medicine Bow Mountains hold gold, diamonds, and platinum while to the west of the Medicine Bows are deposits of lead, zinc and garnet. The Seminoe Mountains, just south of the Granite Mountain Range, hold gold, copper, and serpentine.

This line runs across many aquifers. Possibly the combined power and combined knowledge of these waters fuels the anomalies

found here. Three are sandstone aquifers and one is a sandstone and carbonate rock aquifer. The main influence comes from the lower Tertiary Aquifer near the northern end. Closer to the southern end are upper cretaceous and upper tertiary. The sandstone & carbonate aquifer is in smaller areas and is the Paleozoic aquifer. Carbonate rock is a combination of carbonate minerals, generally limestone and dolostone (Which is composed of the mineral dolomite, a stone found in many megalithic structures around the world.)

Grid Line #4



This energy line runs in a northeasterly-southwesterly direction. It enters Wyoming in the Bighorn Mountains and runs southwest to

the town of Thermopolis, on to Riverton and Rock Springs and entering Colorado near Flaming Gorge National Recreation Area.

The energy line as it runs through the Bighorn Mountains goes to the east of the Bighorn Medicine Wheel. It continues on a path of intersection with Line #3 to the northeast of the town of Worland. This places the Medicine Wheel in the tip of this pointed layout. Maybe this conjunction helps empower the Medicine Wheel. The Bighorn Mountains are granite which probably also adds to the energy of the Medicine Wheel.

As the line continues southerly, it skirts the mountains leading into Yellowstone National Park. The town of Thermopolis lays not far to the west of this line. Thermopolis boasts of having the world's largest mineral hot spring in Hot Spring State Park. The springs produce 8000 gallons of water a day. Also near here is Legend Rock Petroglyph Site. There are over 250 individual petroglyphs on more than 90 panels. Researchers have proved that at many petroglyph sites, there is an increased electrical charge which can be detected. Maybe the combination of hot ancient mineral laden water and the energy line energizes the area.

If a person were to head in a southwesterly direction from Thermopolis, they would find them-self on the Wind River Indian Reservation and near another area with a high number of petroglyphs. These are the Dinwoody Petroglyphs. These glyphs are found in Dinwoody Canyon, a river canyon which would have afforded almost year round habitation for a community. West of Thermopolis are the Owl Creek Mountains where copper, beryl, tourmaline, and jasper can be found.

Back to the grid line. From Thermopolis the line heads toward Riverton and the White Mountains. Although the line skirts the White Mountains to the west, its influence is still felt there. This is another of Wyoming's regions considered sacred by Native Tribes. Hundreds of

petroglyphs can be found carved into the cliffs. Some of which appear to be handprints. Large handprints. The way the handprints appear in the stone, it is as if the stone was semi-soft, much like clay would be in a sculptor's hands, when it had been grabbed or squished by someone. Leaving a handprint for posterity. Could this land of rolling plains and majestic mountains have been home to Giants as well as Little People?

Sasquatch is seen here and the missing people reports are numerous.

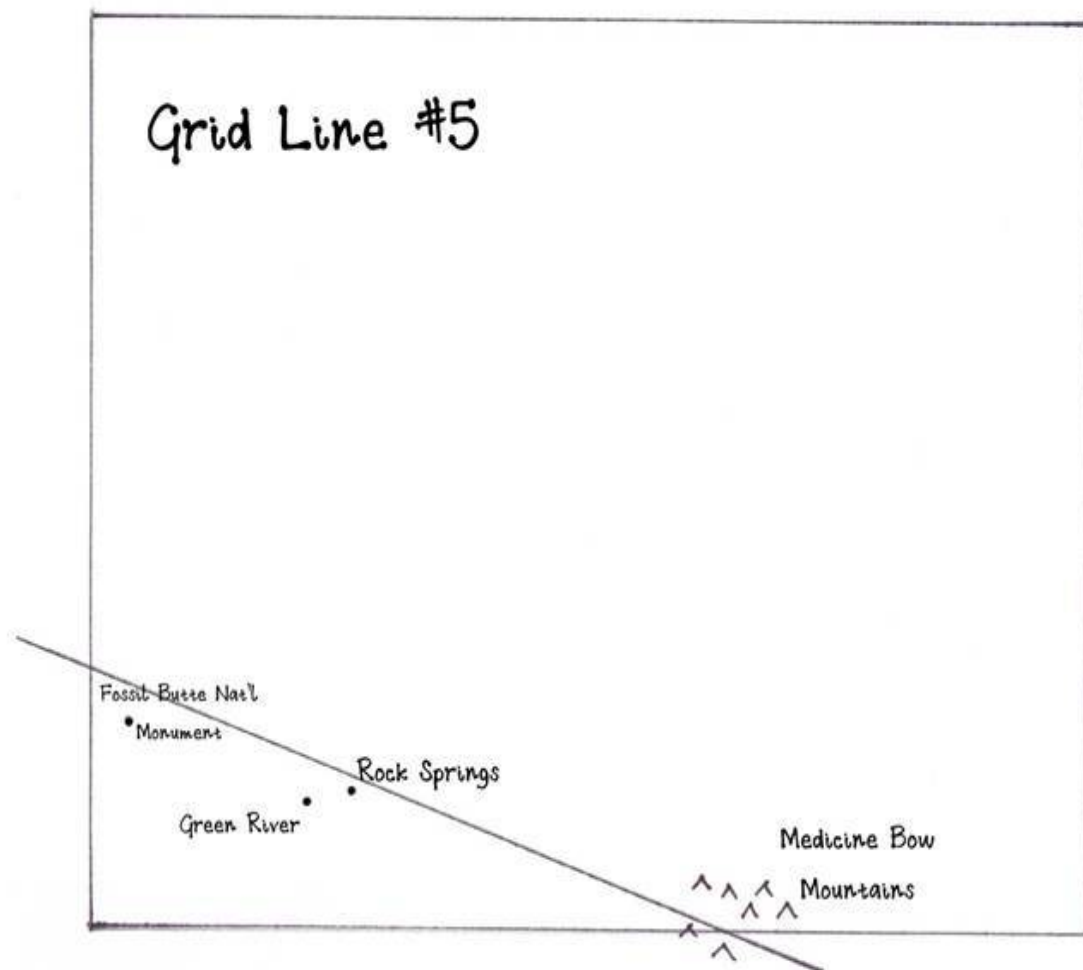
The grid line passes almost directly through the town of Riverton. It is near here that unique geologic formation can be seen - Castle Gardens. It is so named because the wind and water has eroded the sandstone rock into formations that appear to be turrets and towers of a castle. A great number of petroglyphs are found here. It is rumored that another underground military base is found nearby. Supposedly the underground bases have tunnels which extend into nearby states. Could this underground base be connected to the one located near Sheridan?

More evidence of Wyoming's underground cave system is evident near the town of Lander - south of Riverton. Here in Sinks Canyon is a disappearing river. The middle fork of the Popo Agie River comes out of the mountains only to disappear into a cave. It resurfaces about a quarter mile away. But the quantity of water that reappears is much less than what disappears? Maybe the Little People are siphoning off some of the river water.

Rock Springs is the next large town on this grid line. It is in this area that UFOs are commonly seen. Coal was mined here and the land is rich in oil and gas. The line continues on to the east of Flaming Gorge Reservoir. This man-made lake was formed by a dam across the Green River. It is a popular recreational boating spot. Near Rock Springs is an abundance of fossils, petrified wood, and garnets.

This line is similar to Line #3 with influences of several aquifers with the main aquifer of influence being lower tertiary (sandstone) and upper tertiary (sandstone). Both of these are near the northern end. The southern end is over the Colorado Plateau aquifer (sandstone). The Paleozoic Aquifer (sandstone & carbonate rock) is, again in smaller section with a smaller influence.

Grid Line #5



This line runs west northwest to east southeast - from the Idaho/Wyoming border (north of Fossil Butte National Monument) to the intersection of lines in the Medicine Bow Mountains. This line runs

for only a short distant with two intersections with other energy lines, Line #4 and then Line #3 and Line #6. The first intersection is east of Rock Springs.

To the west of Rock Springs, in the town of Green River, lays the Greater Green River Intergalactic Spaceport. Otherwise known as the Green River Airport landing strip. This name change occurred in 1994 and even has the blessing of the FAA. Interesting that UFOs are seen in the skies here – maybe they're waiting for clearance to land...

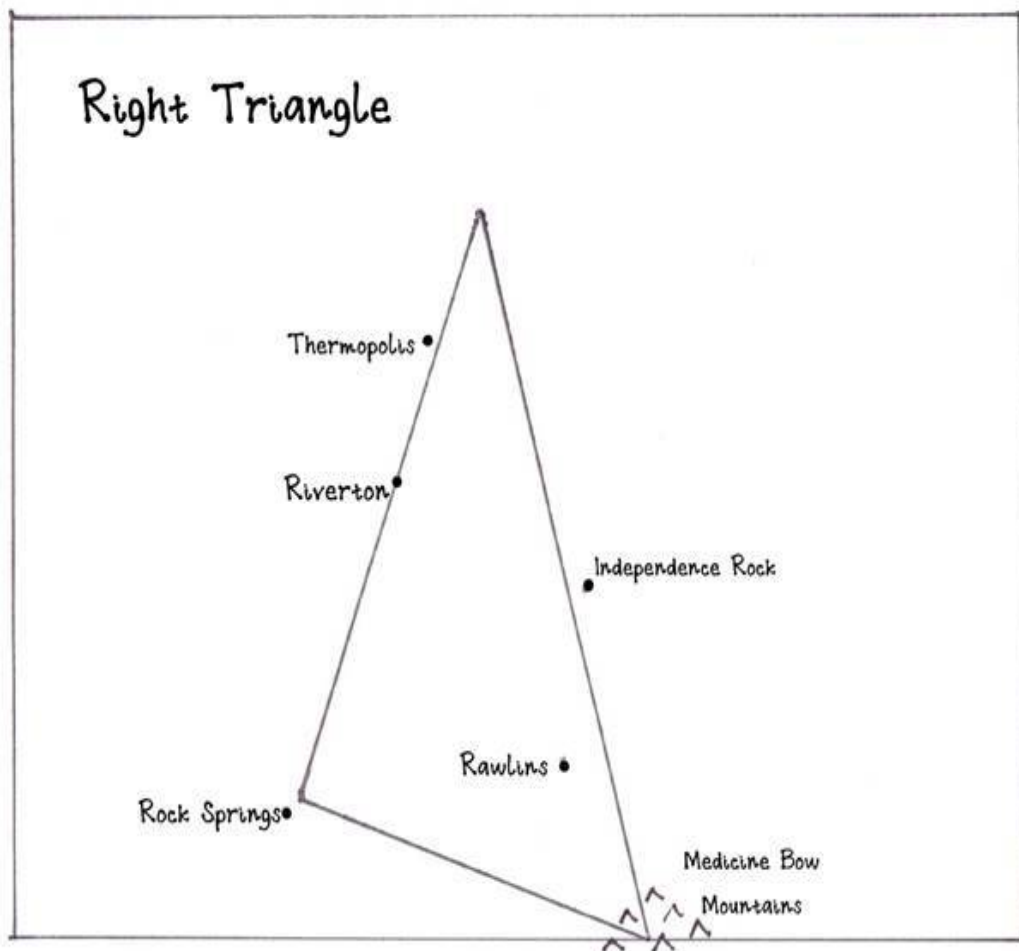
There's nothing stranger than finding the fossils of fish, amphibians, and other aquatic life in the middle of a desert covered in sagebrush. That is what a person will find at Fossil Butte National Monument. This region was once part of a freshwater lake, Fossil Lake, during the Eocene Epoch. This fossil site is not far from the Wyoming/Idaho/Utah border and is near where the energy line begins its track across Wyoming.

As the line continues, it arrives at its intersection with Line #4 outside of Rock Springs. It then crosses the plains before it arrives at its second intersection with Line #3 and Line #6 in the Medicine Bow Mountains.

An interesting terrestrial anomaly can be found to the north of Rock Springs and very near the grid line - singing sand dunes. The Killpecker Dunes make an eerie moaning and rumbling sound when the wind blows across them or even when a person disturbs them. Science states the noise is created because of the size and shape of the grains of sand. But maybe the sands are singing a tune of long ago for those who will listen. And sticking out like a sore thumb in this sandy, almost flat desert landscape is the eroded remains of a volcanic cone. The Boar's Tusk is its name. This rock looks very much like the stark buttes found in the American Southwest.

The majority of this line runs across the Colorado Plateau aquifer (sandstone). The upper Tertiary aquifer (sandstone & carbonate rock) is mainly situated over the confluence of the three lines in the Medicine Bow Mountains.

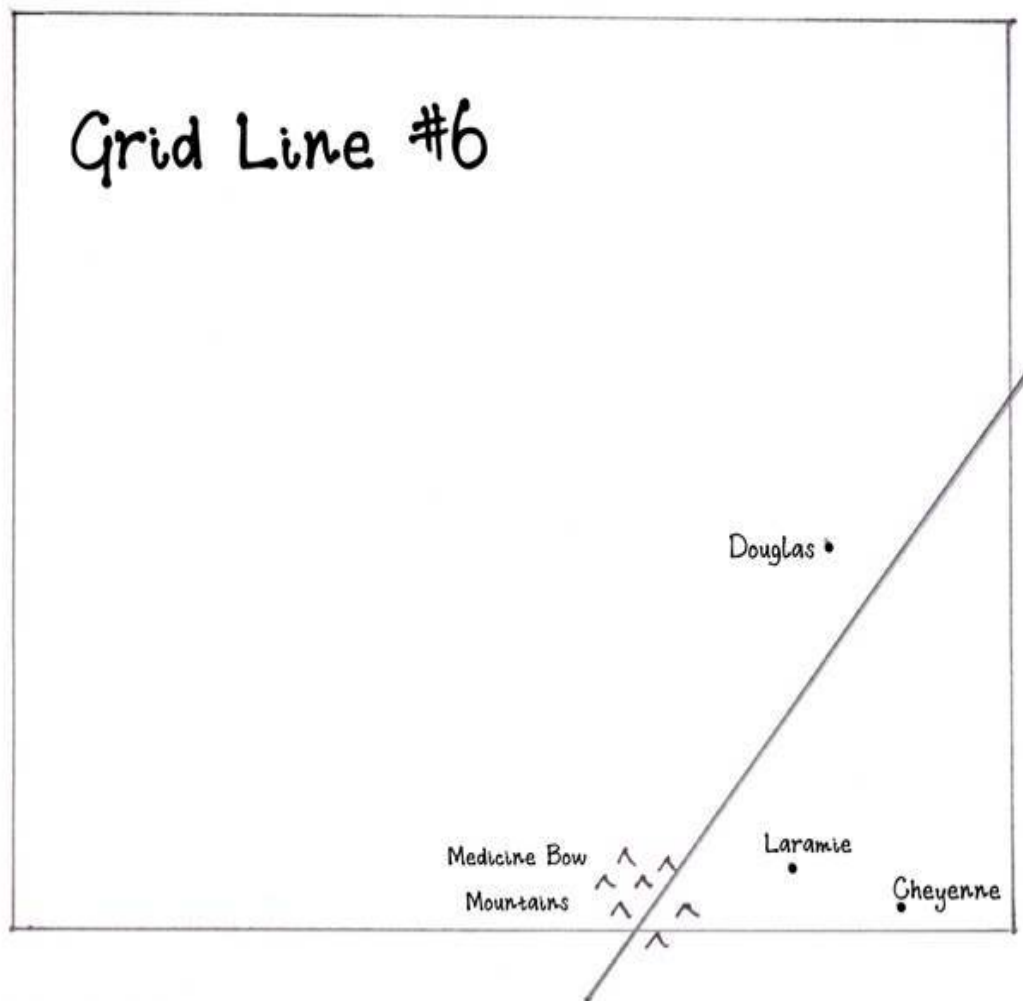
Right Angle Triangle



A right angle triangle is formed by energy lines # 3, #4, #5. This area is vast and sparsely populated. We may never know the true extent of the anomalies found here because of the lack of reports. Odd lights and flying craft are seen in the skies and unusual 'upright lizards' who look remarkably like miniature T-Rexes can be glimpsed running among the sagebrush. Near the eastern side of the triangle,

close to the northern corner, is a 300 acre canyon named Hell's Half Acre. This area is known for its unusual rock formations, deep canyons, and caves. A truly harsh terrain with an even more unforgiving environment.

Grid Line #6



This grid line crosses Wyoming in a northeasterly/southwesterly direction on the east side of the state. It begins south of the town of Newcastle and continues on south of the town of Douglas, intersecting with Line #2, ending up with the intersection of line #3 & #5 in the Medicine Bow Mountains. This land is typical Wyoming with

rolling plains etched by river canyons and punctuated by rugged mountains of interminable age.

This energy line runs strictly across sandstone aquifers - lower tertiary, upper tertiary, and upper cretaceous aquifers.

An interesting tidbit - In the town of Newcastle, a 16 year old boy built a working nuclear fusion reactor in his parent's garage.

Yellowstone

This region is not traversed by any grid lines. But the influence of the volcanic activity found underneath it can be seen and felt in the landscape. Brightly colored mineral pools dot the landscape around Yellowstone National Park. Steam from hot water keeps surrounding areas warm in the chill of winter. Majestic waterfalls and dynamic views are abundant in this region which is thought to be sacred. Many sightings of Sasquatch are reported here along with UFOs. There is a large number of missing people reported in this region.

To the northwest of Riverton, in the Bridger-Teton National Forest is a lush forested area with abundant wildlife. This range is a favorite hunting spot for many. Especially around Brooke's Lake. But another kind of creature is reported close to this location, a large bipedal lizards possibly the same Reptilian species seen near locations of other reported underground bases. Reports of hunters encountering a mysterious beast have been reported. There is also a tale of a local highway going directly into one of these tunnel systems. But because there were so many sightings of reptilians by surface dwellers, the entrance was closed. Could the underground caves found in Wyoming be part of a larger network? Are there subterranean residents living in the caves whose presence on the surface give rise to legends or myths?
